# “What is Said in Therapy and How It Tells Us About the Client, the Therapist, and the Treatment Modality

Dr. Amrhein has attracted national and international attention for his research on motivational interviewing and the study of commitment language. His research has important implications for understanding and predicting changes in drug use. He is an Adjunct Associate Professor of Medical Psychology at Columbia University in New York and he holds a tenured faculty position in the Department of Psychology at Montclair State University in New Jersey. Dr. Amrhein also served on the faculty of the University of New Mexico, where he worked closely with Dr. William R. Miller on studies of motivational interviewing.
